## Step 1

Once your Cabana has been completely assembled, remove the Lower Decorative Finial, located inside the the top center of your Cabana, to expose the threaded mount.

## Step 2

**Note:** Be sure that the set screw is not threaded in far enough to interfere with the threads on the lower hub.

Fully tighten the set screw located at the top of the Ceiling Fan Mounting Bracket using a 1/8" Hex Key.

## Step 3

Your Ceiling Fan is now ready to be installed. For instruction on installing your Ceiling Fan, please refer to your Ceiling Fan Assembly Instructions.
